Warm Days Ahead

As we get closer to the end of the school year, we may encounter some days that will be a little warmer for our students. As we enjoy the weather, it is important to plan ways for our students to maintain a level of comfort during the school day. - Closing blinds to prevent solar loading, especially in the afternoon when it is warmest
- Opening windows in the morning when outdoor air is cool, if possible
- Using natural light and keeping lights off in the classroom



- Limiting physical exertion during the hottest hours
- Encouraging students to take frequent water breaks throughout the day

We are asking for support from our families to please make sure that your child has access to a water bottle that they can fill up throughout their day. You may also wish to make sure that they are wearing sun screen as all of our students are outside during recess and lunch break times.
