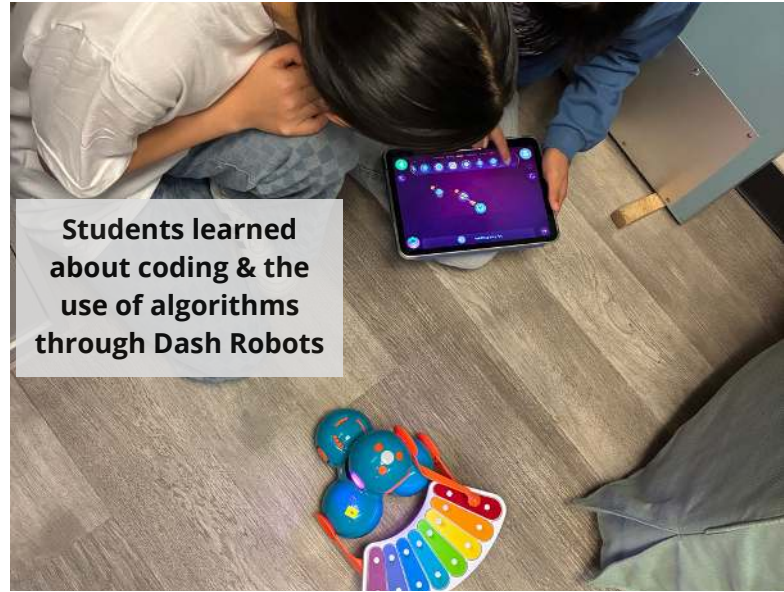
Bridging connections with students at RCS through music - learning new songs and meeting new friends through shared experiences.
