Class Placement Parent Input

Each year at this time, we begin to make school organization plans for September based upon the number of students we know are returning and new registrations that we have received. Before school ends in June, your child's current classroom teacher, resource teacher, educational assistants and administrators will work together to place students for the upcoming school year. These plans are tentative until the first



week in September when final student numbers are known. In the first few days of September, all staff meet to confirm teaching assignments and review student placements. In the organizational meetings, many factors are considered when placing students. These considerations include:

- Learning Styles and Strengths
- ELL Levels

- Work Habits
- Age

- Special Needs
- Friendship Needs and Considerations

- Include important information about your child, both socially and academically, that you feel is important for us to be aware of that will help us in our decision in the placement of your child

- Do not include comments about / requests for specific teachers or division number








HOW WE LEARN AND WORK TOGETHER
