# **Budget Update**

- Treasurer Report for September 23, 2024:
  - As of September 1, this is our financial position
  - o General Account Balance \$37,147.57
  - o Gaming Account Balance \$1,709.20
  - Note the balances are just a snapshot.
- We have yet to receive the Gaming Grant for this school year, applied earlier during 2024 for an estimated total of \$4,400.00. PAC has agreed to pay for \$600.00 from the Gaming account for the Orange Shirt Day Assembly POW WOW Dancer on September 27, 2024.
- Projected revenues comprise mainly of Hot lunch program Food Days twice a week with a total estimate of \$20,600.00 and fundraising initiatives bringing in a total of \$3,050.
- The draft operating budget from September 1, 2024 to August 31, 2025 was presented with new special events and fundraisers such as Movie nights and 50-50 raffle ticket draws for Lunar New Year event. The total estimated Special events expense will be \$2,500.00 and Fundraising expenses will be \$750.00.
- PAC has confirmed a maximum of \$2,000.00 for 2025 graduation and grad related contribution this year. The treasurer will create a google form for reimbursement submission before next PAC meeting.
- The budgeted contribution for school clubs is staying the same as prior year at a maximum of \$500.00. The miscellaneous contingency costs have increased to \$1,000.00 from \$500.00 last year to provide an increased buffer for ad-hoc costs for the increased special events and fundraising initiatives to boost community and student engagement for 2024 to 2025 school year.
- Draft budget to be reviewed and approved by co-chairs, Michelle Miao and Arnold Fok.

#### **Sub-Committees**

    - Search for need vendors and systems as need to improve efficiency.
    - Consider recycling and disposal
  - o Special events Lead: Michelle
    - Planning of existing special events such as: Winter & spring fest, etc.
    - Plan the event within the budget set by PAC.
  - o Grad committee Lead: Natalie, Amy
    - Booth at special events
  - o Fundraising Lead: Arnold
    - Raffle Tickets 50/50 draws need gaming license (\$50 per license)
    - Silent auctions need to gather silent auction items.
    - Recycling bottles and cans within the school.
    - Movie nights need movie license \$500
      - Do once a month
      - Can consider free admission and charge on concessions
      - Should encourage everyone to bring all garbage home
      - Wowk has popcorn machine; previously also bought bulk from Kernels
    - Application of applicable grants.

#### **Hot Lunch**

- Pizza day will be on every Tues. Pizza vendor will be Fusion Pizza
  - o Hot lunch ordering start on Sept 24. First hot lunch will be on Oct 1
  - o Food will be: pizza (cheese, pepperoni, hawaii, veggie, bbq chicken, beef), lasagna, cheesy bread.
  - o In the beginning, we will do individual boxes with the aim to do large boxes later on. This will be based on volunteer availability.
  - o Lunch for pizza has many flavours for now, will refine in Jan.
